2017 Curly Flat Pinot Noir



When Gary Walsh from the Wine Front backs up your excitement in a new wine with a 95+ point score (plus a drinking window up to 2032+) you start to think that you might be onto a good thing. And that's just what has happened with our 2017 Curly Flat Pinot Noir. Needless to say, we're excited to be presenting this wine to our mailing list for the first time.

In the Aug/Sept edition of Halliday Magazine, Curly Flat's winemaker Matt Harrop said of Macedon pinot noir: it typically has "vibrancy, purity, freshness and vitality with good natural acidity". We think that the 2017 incarnation is no exception, and are quietly confident that our loyal customers will feel the same way.

As we head into the last month of winter, a reminder that we have the fires blazing every weekend at Curly Flat from 12 - 5pm. Come in to enjoy the cosy room, convivial atmosphere and charming cats.

2017 Curly Flat Pinot Noir (\$52)



Bouquet: Fresh violets & dried lavender entwine with strawberry and black cherry to form a fresh, fragrant peak. Aromas of leather, fresh earth and autumnal undergrowth merge with coniferous notes, oak spice & black pepper all providing a complex savoury base.

Palate: Luminous yet mouth-filling red threaded black fruits meet fine suede-like tannin that's ushered along by an undercurrent of cooling acidity. Fine mineral length meets with an ethereal epilogue of persisting palate perfume. Cellaring: Drinking well now with the best to come over 10+ years.

What are other people saying...?

I'm quite particular about Pinot Noir. There's styles I very much like, and those that I don't but may still rate highly, where appropriate. Anyway, here's a style I do like, and I'd expect that it will have broad appeal too... The main thing I like here, is that there's an earthy/mineral thing going on that sets it apart from the pack. Cherry, strawberry, spice, mint, autumnal, yet still bright with cranberry acidity, wonderful graphite tannin, a coolness and composure without compromising this sort of salt-of-the-earth integrity thingy. Finish is pure and mineral infused, with insistent tannin pushing it long. Fair to say I think this is very good, with more to come. 95+ points Gary Walsh, The Wine Front

2017 Curly Flat Chardonnay

I adore the energy and the purity in this wine. Fruit is the hero in this wine with faint white peach and lemon flavours. Happenings at Curly Flat

From the vineyard: With vintage 2019 safely in barrel, pruning is once again our focus. After the wettest June since 1996 our skilled team face frosty days to set the structure not only for 2020, but for the many vintages to follow. Once pruning is complete, we'll nourish our soils with organic fertiliser and lay down mulch to retain precious moisture. Oh. And later in the year we'll be planting more vines, Pinot Noir of course! More on that next time...

From the winery: After three months in barrel, the nuances of our 2019 wines are coming more clearly into view. The warm, dry season has delivered Pinot Noir of great depth of flavour along with fine, structural tannin. Cool nights ensured that fragrance and length have all remained intact, all of which makes for wines of promise. Chardonnay looks to be a wine of real impact with vibrantly intense fruit and crystalline length, with degrees of complexing malolactic fermentation still to come. And let's not forget our White Pinot and Pinot Gris both of which are looking to follow the same path as their 2018 counterparts: by which we mean very tasty!
